### Decisions of the 125<sup>th</sup> Management Team 2010 (14 June 2010) – ESE 25368

BT 125-1 (strategy)	On 10 June, a ‘day of appreciation’ was organised for people giving service to the ESE, who are not employed by the ESE (i.e. cleaning staff, security guards, postal workers, etc). The ESE wanted to let them know how much we appreciate their day-to-day dedication and devotion. A nice lunch was offered to these employees in the Faculty Club. BT 125-2 (education)	<p>The MT decides to agree with the proposal of the Examination Board to tighten up control of the bachelor thesis requirements when admitting students to the Master phase. The current procedure will be maintained, the inspection of the procedure however will be tightened:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• On 1 October of every year, the Examination Board, in cooperation with the ESC, will check if a thesis grade is registered in OSIRIS of each and every student that has (provisional) been admitted to the Master. Only these students will receive a special code. Only with this code Master students can actually register for Master exams.</li><li>• If the bachelor thesis is not yet registered in OSIRIS, the student will not receive this special code until the registration has been carried out properly.</li><li>• The procedure to tighten up control of this procedure will be communicated to students and teachers via the website and a special e-mail message.</li><li>• The commencing date of the new procedure will be 1 September 2010.</li></ul>
